



Manual 19 Proposed Friendly Amendment

- Proposed revision to Manual 19, Attachment B in the section entitled "Adjustment Review" to clarify the responsibilities of the PJM EDC and/or LSE regarding the load forecast adjustment process.
- Present language indicates that the EDC and/or LSE will be responsible for summarizing all forecast adjustments reflected in the Load Forecast, which could be misinterpreted to include final changes PJM makes to adjustments they have received.
- Proposed language clarifies that the public documentation provided by the EDC and/or LSE is limited to providing details on the load adjustment process and methodology the EDC and/or LSE used to arrive at the load adjustments in its own data submission to PJM.



Manual 19, Attachment B: Load Forecast Adjustment Guidelines

Existing language:

Adjustment Review – each proposed load forecast adjustment will be reviewed with the Load Analysis Subcommittee prior to inclusion in the load forecast. Each requesting EDC and/or LSE will be expected to present on their adjustment request including backup documentation at a September/October LAS meeting. The final decision on any load adjustment is made by PJM and will be reflected in the Load Forecast.

Any adjustment that is reflected in the Load Forecast will be summarized by the requesting EDC and/or LSE in a public document describing the method and forecasting approach followed. This public document will be posted by PJM with the load report materials.

Proposed language:

Adjustment Review – each proposed load forecast adjustment will be reviewed with the Load Analysis Subcommittee prior to inclusion in the load forecast. Each requesting EDC and/or LSE will be expected to present on their adjustment request including backup documentation at a September/October LAS meeting and also provide backup documentation summarizing details of the EDC's and/or LSE's large load adjustment process and methodology. This public document will be posted by PJM with the final load report materials. The final decision on any load adjustment is made by PJM and will be reflected in the Load Forecast.

Any adjustment that is reflected in the Load Forecast will be summarized by the requesting EDC and/or LSE in a public document describing the method and forecasting approach followed. This public document will be posted by PJM with the load report materials.
