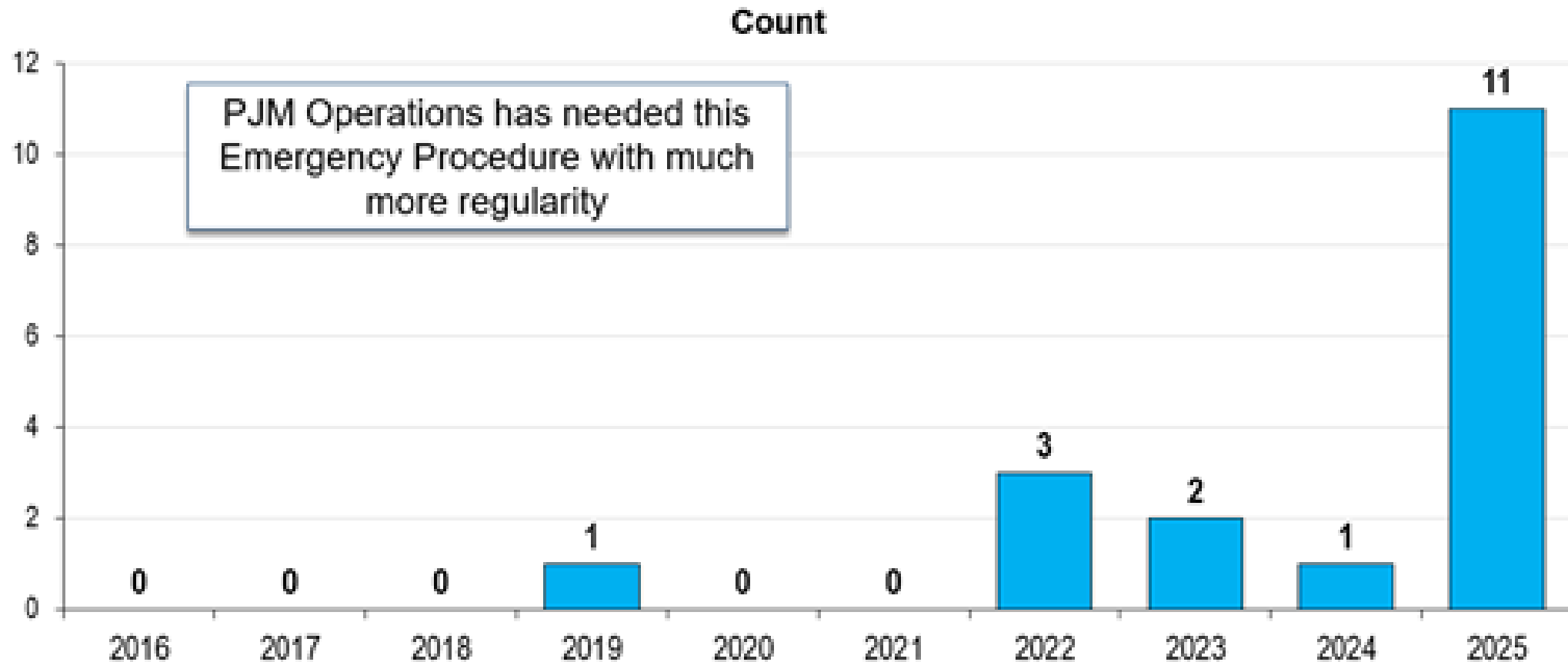


Expansion of Provisional Service

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Growing Resource Adequacy Concerns



(EEA-1) is a notice issued by a Balancing Authority (BA) when all available generation resources are committed to meet electricity demand, firm transactions, and reserve commitments, and there are concerns about maintaining required contingency reserves.

- Projects in Phase 3 of the Generation Interconnection Process (GIP)
 - Have completed one full round of interconnection studies
 - Require a Phase 3 System Impact Study
 - Require a Facilities Studies for necessary system reinforcements

If the projects have reached some level of completion, they could be eligible to generate on an energy-only basis under certain conditions and prior to the completion of certain studies.

- Develop mechanism to identify projects ready to deliver energy to the system in Phase 3
 - Ensure Transmission System safety and reliability are fully maintained
 - Not to harm the GIPs ability to efficiently study Interconnection Requests
 - Applicable to projects targeting a Generator Interconnection Agreement

Key Activities

- Education concerning PJM's current interim deliverability process
 - Education concerning the current state of other RTO/ISOs provisional service processes
 - Discussion on the proposed solution options and alternatives
 - Development of a Final Proposal
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- Targeting a 10 month timeframe for the completion of this work

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
