 - Verizon currently has reduced support (@vtext.com, @vzwpix.com)

 - Notice has been sent to identified users



Actions

- Explore options from your mobile carrier, if available.






Message Definitions

PAI Trigger tags will change to potential PAI tags.










Banner Text


- Dashboard banner text change to "A potential PAI Emergency Procedures message is active. <u>Data Miner</u> is the PAI data of record."

Banner Text


 Message banner text change to "This Emergency Procedures message type is a potential PAI, see Data Miner".





Email Notifications


- Remove "PAI" from Emergency Procedures email notifications.
 - Only applicable to those with Emergency Procedures logins who have set up their Emergency Procedures profiles to receive Emergency Procedures email notifications.





Dark vs. Light Theme


- Current Emergency Procedures user interface is presented in light theme
- Dark theme option will be added
 - Available only to logged in users
 - Last theme selected will be saved and presented to the user at next login
 - Light theme is the default

Emergency Procedures Background

The Emergency Procedures tool informs PJM members, PJM personnel and other interested parties about important and/or emergency events as they occur within the PJM Regional Transmission Organization (RTO). Examples of emergency events include hot weather alerts, transmission loading relief (TLR) procedures and minimum generation events.

Key Product Features

- Allows PJM dispatchers and reliability coordinators to post emergency procedures messages for all to see.
- User access, which permits email notification setup, to Emergency Procedures is available in Account Manager.
 - Guest access is also available without login.
