PJM Command Line Interface (CLI) Retirement

- JDK 8 (Java Development Kit) support for PJM CLI will end
 - July 2026
- Retired due to vulnerability remediation
- Those using PJM CLI to access PJM REST endpoints will need to download a new version.

- New version will be ready by May

- Download by July 2026

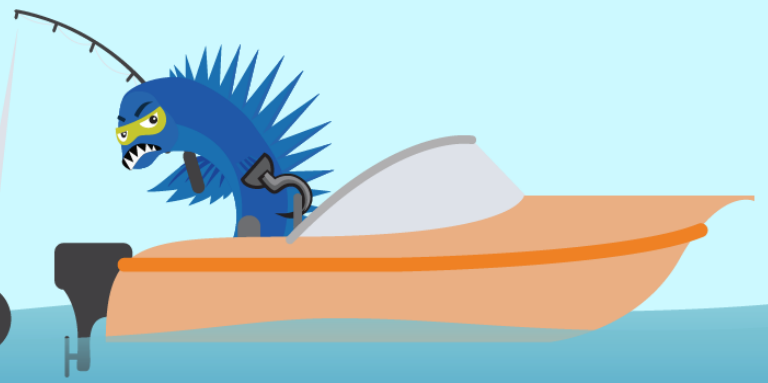
