- Upgrading environment from SharePoint 2019 to SharePoint Subscription Edition
- SharePoint 2019 is reaching 'end-of-life' support by Microsoft.
- Users should notice very few differences after the upgrade.

- PJM Connect (PJM's external SharePoint environment) is being upgraded to SharePoint Subscription edition in June 2026.
- The upgrade is due to the current version going out of support in 2026.
- The user experience will be very similar to what you see today.
- Users will have an opportunity to test the environment prior to go-live. The testing environment will be available May 26th and you will be able to access the environment using your active Account Manager account. URL for testing: <https://connectsps.pjm.com>
- The actual go-live will involve a short outage of the application. The new version of SharePoint will replace the current existing URL of <https://connect.pjm.com> to preserve links. This upgrade will also not impact accessing File Transfers via APIs.
- There will be a Train environment available soon after launch for developing projects.

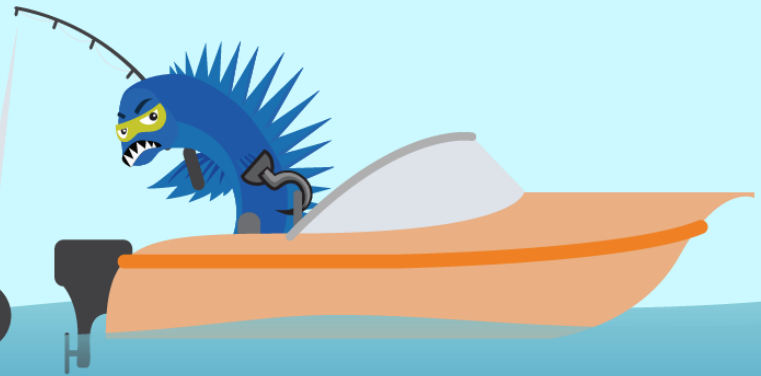
