### **Discussion Items. (3:00 – 4:00)**

#### **1. ISAC Workbook – 2025 RTEP**

Ben Sloan (OPSI) discussed plans to release a public version of the ISAC workbook submitted for the 2025 RTEP. ISAC will redact the deactivations policy index tab, and leave the rest of the content unchanged.

#### **2. ISAC Assumptions 2025 RTEP**

Tim Burdis (PJM) presented modeling challenges associated with the 2025 RTEP driven by a significant increase in PJM's 2025 load forecast and deactivations. PJM may need to make assumptions about new supply to maintain system balance. PJM asked ISAC members for guidance on how to approach this sensitivity analysis.

#### **3. Grid-Enhancing Technologies Reference Guides**

Chris Callaghan (PJM) provided an overview of four technical guides recently published on GETs. The guides include background, technical considerations, potential benefits, and implementation barriers. PJM has launched a dedicated webpage to house these resources.

#### **4. Evaluation of Increased Loss of Source Limit**

Susan McGill (PJM) gave a brief update on a joint RTO study evaluating ISO New England's proposal to raise its loss of source limit to 2,000 MW. PJM is supporting the study and will assess impacts once ISO-NE finalizes its request.
