Discussion Items. (3:00 – 4:00)

1. Reliability Resource Initiative

Susan McGill (PJM) reported that PJM received 94 applications in the RRI window and will select 50 for Transition Cycle 2. PJM will publish queue numbers and project information, subject to confidentiality rules.

2. 2025 RTEP Window 1 - Overview

Susan McGill and Matt Bernstein (PJM) reviewed the 2025 RTEP process. The window will open in June. Load growth (+16 GW) and deactivations are driving significant reliability challenges. PJM is relying heavily on the interconnection queue to balance the system. PJM will also run sensitivities on offshore wind schedules and on ISAC-provided assumptions.

3. 2025 RTEP Window 1 - ISAC Assumptions

Matt Bernstein (PJM) reviewed PJM's statement on ISAC policy inputs. PJM will run a sensitivity on ~11,000 MW of policy-driven deactivations by 2030 and compare the results to the base case. PJM also incorporates state electrification policies and relevant queue resources into the base case.
