

# State Policies Workbook – Order 1920

- The initial policy categories in the State Policies Workbook reflected PJM’s original LTRTP workshop series and proposed framework (pre-FERC Order No. 1920). These policy assumptions were also used in the “LTRTP Workshop Policy Study.”
- PJM intends to work with the states to enhance the workbook’s template and capture policy inputs necessary for Order 1920 scenario development. This will include:
  - Identifying how policies are categorized according to Order 1920 scenario factor categories.
  - Detailing how broadly-defined policies can be implemented and reflected in transmission planning models, as necessary.
  - Adding additional policy categories, as necessary (\*update from 10/1/2024 presentation).

# Example Order 1920 Factor Category Matrix – Deactivations

Order 1920 Scenario Factors	Deactivations
<b>Factor 1</b> - Federal, state, and local laws and regulations that affect the future resource mix and demand	X
<b>Factor 2</b> - Federal, state, and local laws and regulations on decarbonization and electrification	X
<b>Factor 3</b> - State-approved utility integrated resource plans and expected supply obligations for load-serving entities	X
<b>Factor 4</b> - Trends in technology and fuel costs within and outside of the electricity supply industry, including shifts toward electrification of buildings and transportation	
<b>Factor 5</b> - Resource retirements	X
<b>Factor 6</b> - Generator interconnection requests and withdrawals	
<b>Factor 7</b> - Utility and other federal, state, and local goals that affect the future resource mix and demand	X

**Note** – This example matrix for deactivations is purely illustrative and is not to be considered a final determination made by PJM for which Order 1920 Factor Categories that deactivations will fall into. That type of determination will be made during the Assumptions stage of each Order 1920 long-term planning cycle.

- ISAC and PARSEC can think about how to best manage future iterations and different versions of the State Policies Workbook.
- PJM will work with PARSEC on developing an Order 1920 version of the State Policies Workbook.
