PJM Interconnection and the IMM

Issue Content

This Issue Charge seeks to address scenarios where a Market Seller (or its designated agent) obtains fuel cost estimates from an affiliated fuel supplier for purposes of submitting cost-based offers. Stakeholders will review and consider incorporating revisions in Manual 15: Cost Development Guidelines to make clear that a Market Seller (or its designated agent) may not use fuel cost estimates from an affiliated fuel supplier in cost-based offers calculations.

Key Work Activities and Scope

1. Review Status Quo PJM Manual 15: Cost Development Guidelines and educate stakeholders on the concerns that may arise if a Market Seller (or its designated agent) uses a fuel cost estimate from an affiliated fuel supplier in cost-based offers.
2. Discuss proposed solution to address the concerns.

Proposed revisions to PJM Manual 15: Cost Development Guidelines
