

Load Management and PRD Testing

- 3rd year of the revised Load Management (LM) and Price Responsive Demand (PRD) Testing Process
- DR Hub process is stable and fewer process questions being asked
- Going forward, details will not be provided each month for settlement due dates and meter data needed to calculate CBLs

- Testing window is posted one week in advance by 10 am Monday morning at:

Or use endpoint:

- Test Date is posted 1 day before Test
- DR Hub sends electronic notification at start of Test according to Lead Time of registration

- After a LM or PRD Test:
 - Retest process (if desired)
 - Test Emergency Energy Settlements
 - Compliance

- Retest (if desired) – can only determine performance once all registrations in zone are tested (annual + summer only):
 - If test reductions $> 75\%$ of commitment, CSP can self schedule retest(s) in DR Hub (must be in same season)
 - If test reductions $\leq 75\%$ of commitment, CSP has 46 days from the test date to request that PJM schedule a single retest

- CSP Retest (initial test > 75%)
 - Start/end instructions sent from DR Hub in response to normal CSP polling according to registrations' lead time
 - Email sent at notification time
- PJM Retest (initial test ≤ 75%)
 - Day Before PJM Retest Date:
 - Load Management/PRD Retest Summary event(s) posted to DR Hub Events section by 10:00 EPT the day before retest date
 - CSP should monitor DR Hub webpage and/or use web service function to obtain retest date
 - Since retests are CSP specific they are not posted to the Test webpage
 - Event Day
 - Start/end instructions sent from DR Hub in response to normal CSP polling according to registrations' lead time
 - Email sent at notification time

- Compliance will be determined after the Delivery Year
- Substitution of Load Management event performance for Tests
 - Through 2027/2028, Load Management events (non-PAI) may substitute for a Test
 - If you plan to substitute a Test with a non-PAI Load Management event, please mark your calendars to take action to substitute the event in DR Hub in June, after the Delivery Year is over
- Starting 2028/2029, registrations that have been part of a Load Management Event (PAI or non-PAI), during the DY will no longer need to Test

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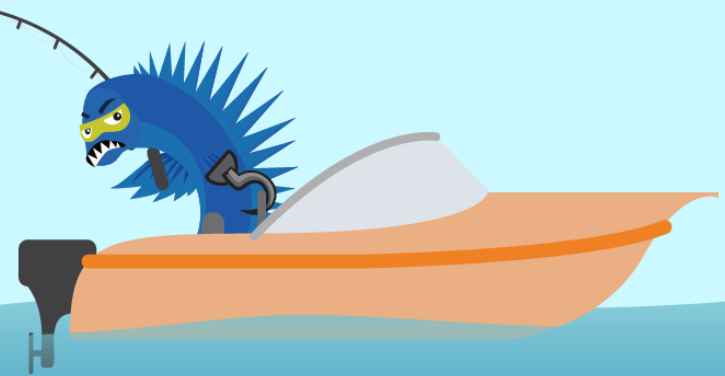
