	The PJM 2026 Fall Restoration Drill provides an opportunity for all applicable entities to comply with NERC Standards EOP-005-3 & EOP-006-3.			
	TO Expectations:			
	- The top-down, or a combination of top-down and bottom-up, approach to system restoration is emphasized for the Fall drill utilizing the PJM approved TO system restoration plan while adhering to PJM Manual 36. - Utilize any “Cross Zonal Black Start Units” identified in the TO restoration plan. - Keep nuclear units informed on the status & estimated time of safe shutdown power. (SIMULATED) - Contact participating Generator Operators (GOP) within the TO zone to request information on availability and time to start. - o If you would like a unit online, request the GOP to commence a simulated start-up for drill purposes only.

	- PJM Dispatchers will be on-site, at PJM or TO location, to answer any questions and interact with the TO during the restoration drill. <u>GOP Expectations: (if participating)</u> <i>Note: Generator Operators are not required to participate in the Fall drill unless specifically requested by the TO</i> - Participate as needed with the TO during the restoration drill in the zone where your units are located. - Provide requested information to the TO regarding unit availability and/or unit start-up times. - Document and send updates to PJM as requested (per Manual 36) with unit data in the requested TO zone. - The drill will utilize real-time generation statuses & outages that exist on the date(s) of the drill. <i>Note: PJM's simulator room is considered a third control room; therefore, GOP personnel are not permitted to attend the drill in the PJM simulator room.</i> Each drill day, PJM will have a morning meeting with all participants to discuss the scope of the restoration drill. Participating GOP will be provided with the TO drill phone number(s). At the conclusion of each drill, PJM & the TO Drill Coordinator will conduct a restoration drill debrief.
