

Reliability Resource Initiative (RRI) Status Update

April 2025 IPS
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Interconnection Projects

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- RRI Application window was opened for 10 Business Days from Feb. 28, 2025 – March 14, 2025
- Total 97 Projects applied
 - A total of 8 Projects were either deemed ineligible based on the established RRI criteria, did not meet the Application requirements, or were withdrawn at the applicant's request.
 - Total 89 Projects met RRI eligibility criteria totaling 21.4 GW of nameplate capacity (MWE)
 - Of these projects, 46 involved uprates, and 43 proposed new generation.
