# What Is An Interim Deliverability Study

- PJM performs interim deliverability studies to ensure no impacts to the grid for the following three types of requests:
  - Request to be in service earlier than their original base case study year
  - Before the completion of required Network Upgrades that are listed as contingent facilities in Interconnection Agreement (GIA)
  - Long Term Firm (LTF) service request that is less than 5 years request and wants to be studied on year to year basis
- The study evaluates whether the project can deliver Megawatts reliably to the system for a given delivery year



# IDS case selection and study methodology

- Interim deliverability studies primarily consist of load flow studies performed using the most recent summer peak RTEP case for a given delivery year.
- Depending on type of contingent and/or required upgrade identified during a different analysis (light load, stability, short circuit etc), additional interim study types may be required.
- In alignment with the interconnection studies for Transitional Cycle 2, beginning with the 2028/2029 delivery year, PJM may incorporate a winter study into the Interim Deliverability Study process.
- PJM will be shifting the approach of the interim deliverability study for 2027/28 and later case years from serial to cluster study




- IDS results are only shared with email addresses provided in the SharePoint
- The results of Interim Deliverability Study are ONLY valid for the delivery year that the project was studied for.
- Interim Deliverability Study results of one year does not guarantee the same result for the subsequent year(s).
- A project may be deemed deliverable for one delivery year but not deliverable for the subsequent year.
- Where technically possible PJM does grant partial deliverability as part of interim deliverability study.



# Interim Deliverability Study (IDS) Timeline

IDS is performed once for each delivery year (June 1<sup>st</sup> – May 31<sup>st</sup>)

# Interim Deliverability Study Request Frequency and Timing

- A New Service Request in need of an Interim Deliverability Study must request an individual study for each delivery year that the conditions requiring the need for the study exist.
- PJM will only perform one study per year in time for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Incremental Auction for the upcoming delivery year.
- PJM no longer performs the studies in advance of the Base Residual Auction for any given delivery year and will not perform Interim Deliverability Studies for future delivery years ahead of the current study schedule

## Administrative and Process Updates

- Developers will be required to post \$2500 non-refundable study deposit fee in advance for each application they make on SharePoint
- SharePoint application is only open for an upcoming delivery year
- PJM IDS does not ensure deliverability in another impacted ISO



## **Existing IDS request process**

Developer sends request for IDS to PJM PM

PJM PM records the request for IDS

PJM performs IDS and email the results to developers

## **New IDS request process**

Developer make request for IDS in IDS SharePoint site PJM performs IDS and email the results to developers listed in SharePoint

#### 2026-27 Delivery Year Interim Deliverability Study Request Form

This form will only be used for 2026/27 Delivery year Interim Deliverability Study. The results from this study will only apply to the mentioned delivery year. If you want your project to studied for subsequent delivery years, you will need to make separate request. The results from this study does NOT guaranty the same results for subsequent delivery years.

Refer to (i) PJM Manual 14H, Section 4.10.1.4 and (ii) PJM Manual 18, Section 4.2.4 for Eligibility Requirement of PJM Interim Deliverability Study

Requests for interim deliverability studies for a particular delivery year shall be made a minimum of ten months prior to the start of that delivery year.
 Only Long Term Firm (LTF) projects requesting Transmission Service Rights less than 5 years, projects with an executed final interconnection agreement or have confirmation that they will receive a final interconnection agreement by the 3rd Incremental Auction date may participate in the PJM interim deliverability study for that delivery year.
