

SMECO's Large Load Addition Outlook

Background

- SMECO is a distribution cooperative serving all or part of four counties south of Washington, DC
- 91% of customers are residential
- All-time system peak = 1,036 MW (Jan. 2025)
- SMECO has received numerous requests from prospective customers for large loads



Methodology

- Only submitted projects in the 'study phase'
- Demand submitted = 70% of capacity
- 5-year linear load ramp from in-service date
 - Example: 250 MW load in 2029

MW Capacity	50	100	150	200	250



Forecasted Large Load Additions

- 1,430 MW forecast to remain flat through the remainder of the 20-year forecast horizon
- Numbers displayed are aggregate amounts across SMECO's service territory.
