# 5. Ongoing MIC Special Session – Operating Reserve Clarification for Resources Operating as Requested by PJM

Starting in September 2023, PJM held special Market Implementation Committee (MIC) sessions to clarify and/or enhance rules governing the calculation of Balancing Operating Reserve credits paid to supply resources determined to be operating as requested by PJM and how such determination is made. A comprehensive walkthrough of the PJM/IMM Proposal occurred during the December 9, 2024 MIC Special Session meeting. Please reference the MIC committee page for past materials. Committee voting at the April 2, 2025 MIC meeting resulted in endorsement of the proposed solution



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package. A first read of the proposed solution was conducted at the May 21, 2025 MRC meeting. A special MRC Page Turn session was held on June 26, 2025. MRC voting is targeted to take place at the July 23, 2025 MRC meeting and MC voting targeted for the August 20, 2025 MC meeting.

These discussions occur in a context where resulting rule changes may be submitted to FERC for approval, or may reflect regulatory mandates established by state authorities.

If prohibited topics are raised, the Chair will redirect the conversation. If the discussion continues, participants may be asked to leave the meeting or the meeting may be adjourned.
