PJM is launching an updated eDART Data Request to collect emission rates and operating limitations for thermal generation resources. We encourage Generation Owners to work closely with their MOC/eDART contacts to ensure complete and accurate submissions **by 23:59 on Tuesday, June 30, 2026**. Below please find a copy of the notification that was sent to the affected eDART GO Contacts.

Generator Emission Rates Data Request

Attention eDART Gen. Contacts: ACTION REQUIRED FOR ALL THERMAL GENERATION RESOURCES

Improved emissions data enhances PJM's situational awareness and supports more informed dispatch decisions. With better visibility into unit limits, we can help (better) anticipate constraints, reduce operational surprises (unexpected operational issues), and support compliance benefiting both reliability and your operations. PJM will use this data to track run hours and starts against emissions limits to better anticipate when units may approach environmental constraints.

This **mandatory** request in accordance Manual 14-D, Section 7.3.5 Fuel and Emissions Reporting applies to all thermal resources. Questions have been refined based on last year's feedback to improve data quality. Please also use the final question to share any additional context or concerns.

As noted above, the data request is mandatory for Generation Owners and Market Participants with thermal resources and the obligation to respond is not excused, even if a third-party asset manager or other third-party contractor is responsible for submitting eDART data. Failure to comply with this Data Request may result in potential referral to FERC Office of Enforcement and is potentially actionable as a violation of the Tariff, the applicable ISA, and/or Operating Agreement section 11.3.1.

Please note that PJM will share all Data Request responses with its independent market monitor, Monitoring Analytics, LLC. In addition, data responses could be requested by regulators, and PJM would share with member notice only in accordance with the PJM Operating Agreement, section 18.17.
