EOP-005-3 – System Restoration from Blackstart Resources

R10. Each Transmission Operator shall participate in its Reliability Coordinator's restoration drills, exercises, or simulations as requested by its Reliability Coordinator.

R16. Each Generator Operator shall participate in its Reliability Coordinator's restoration drills, exercises, or simulations as requested by its Reliability Coordinator.

EOP-006-3 – System Restoration Coordination

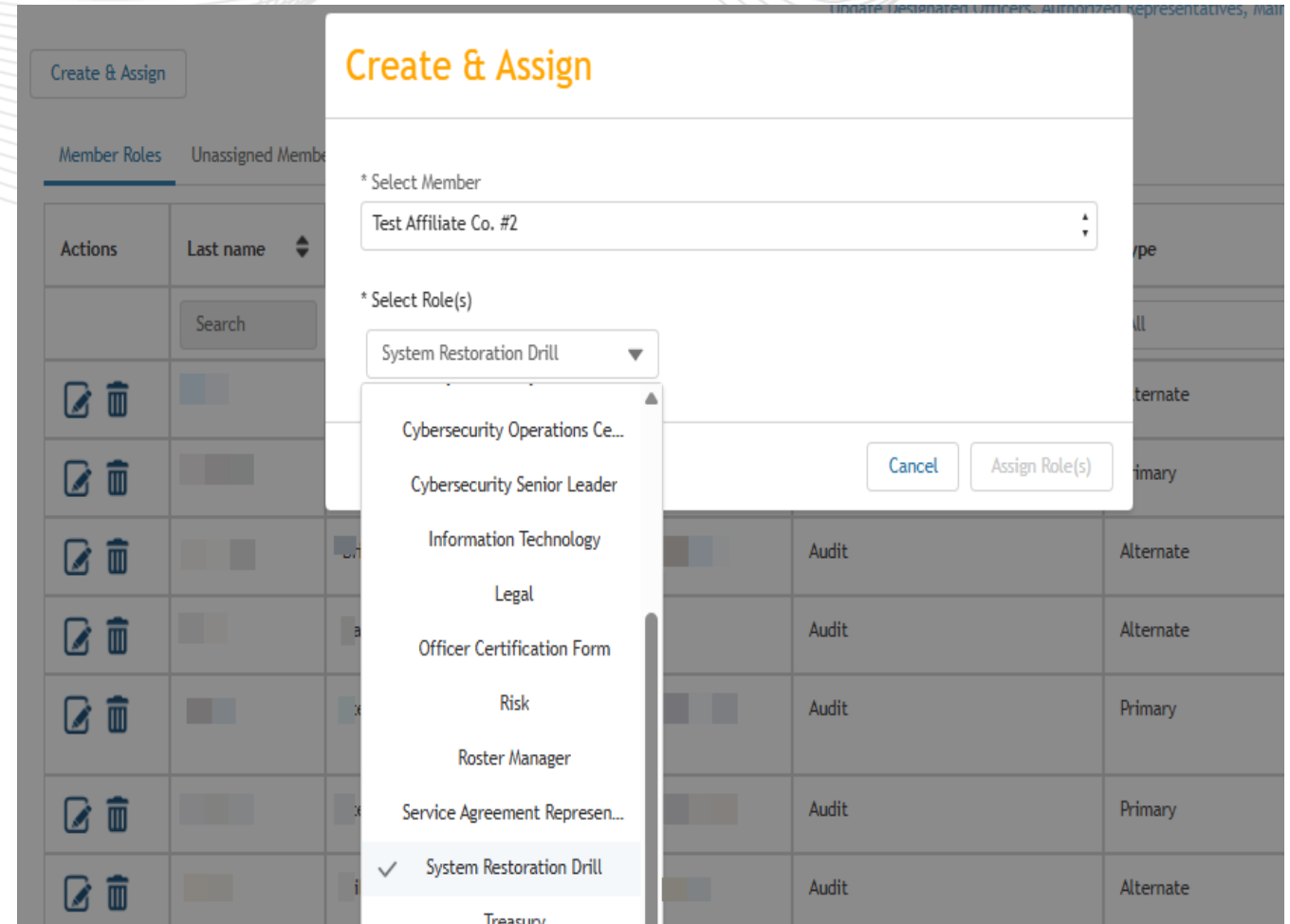
8.1. Each Reliability Coordinator shall request each Transmission Operator identified in its restoration plan and each Generator Operator identified in the Transmission Operators' restoration plans to participate in a drill, exercise, or simulation at least once every two calendar years.

R10. Each Transmission Operator shall participate in its Reliability Coordinator's restoration drills, exercises, or simulations as requested by its Reliability Coordinator.

R16. Each Generator Operator shall participate in its Reliability Coordinator's restoration drills, exercises, or simulations as requested by its Reliability Coordinator.

- Utilize TO restoration plans (Exhibit 10) to determine generators to invite
- Utilize Resource Tracker for GOP contact information
 - Information not always accurate
 - Update timelines are limited

- Plan to use Contact Management for future restoration drills
 - Not limited to certain timeframe for updates
- TOs and GOPs in TO restoration plan responsible for keeping contacts up to date

- Potential language planned for PJM Manual 36, Attachment D: Restoration Drill Guide:

Transmission Owners with a load serving obligation in the PJM territory, and Generator Operators that are integral to a Transmission Owner's restoration plan (Black Start units, nuclear generation and operators of critical load units) are required to provide, at a minimum, a primary and secondary Restoration Drill contact to the Contact Management section of the Membership Management Community. If you do not have access, please contact your Company Account Manager (CAM).

In accordance with NERC standard EOP-006 R8 and R8.1:

- PJM expects participation in system restoration drills by all Transmission Owners with a load serving obligation, as specified in the scope of the drill.

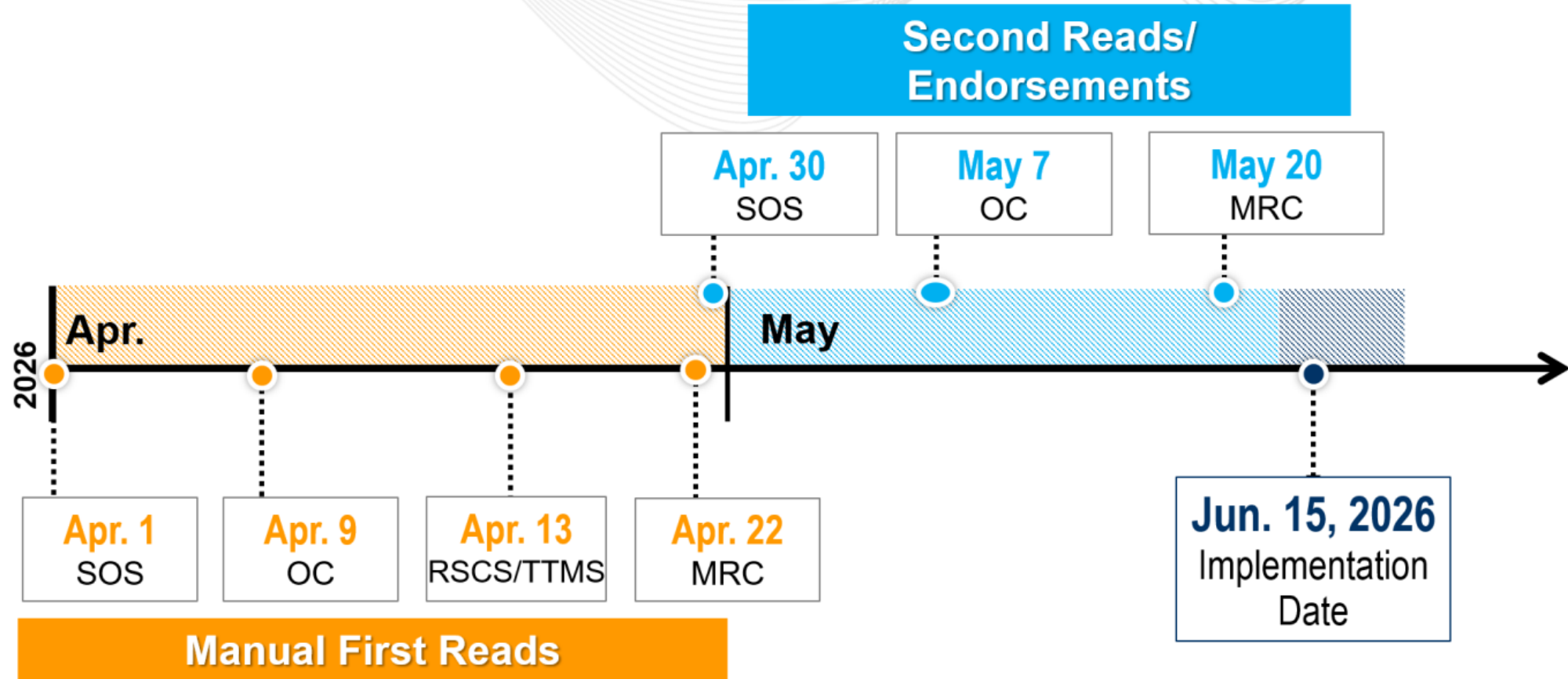

Attachment D: Restoration Drill Guide

- PJM invites Generator Operators that are integral to the restoration plan to participate in the Spring Restoration drills. This includes the Black Start unit operators, nuclear generation operators and operators of critical load units. Other Generator Operators may be invited as requested. Generator Operators participate from their respective control rooms though in some cases may be in the member TO training rooms. The Generator Operator will communicate with the TO and PJM operators during the drill regarding issues of cranking power, unit startup and unit loading.
- PJM encourages Generator Operator participation in the Fall TO-specific drills, but does not require it.



Transmission Owner restoration plans are tested on at least a semi-annual basis, consistent with the PJM Restoration Drill schedule. As part of the drill post-assessment, PJM and Transmission Owners verify the plan resources and procedures. Additional Transmission Owner simulations or tabletop exercises are conducted to ensure Transmission Owner personnel are

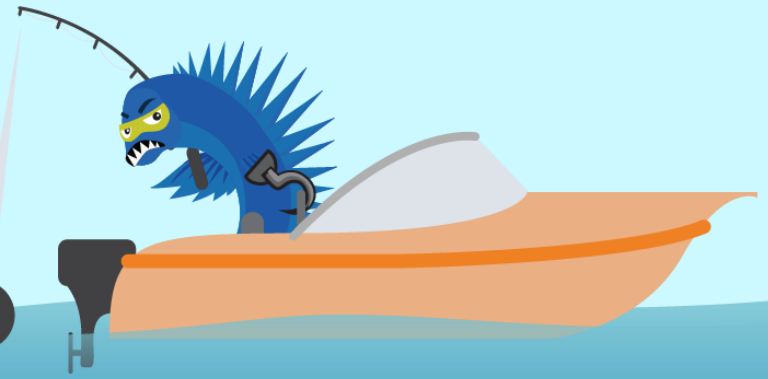
