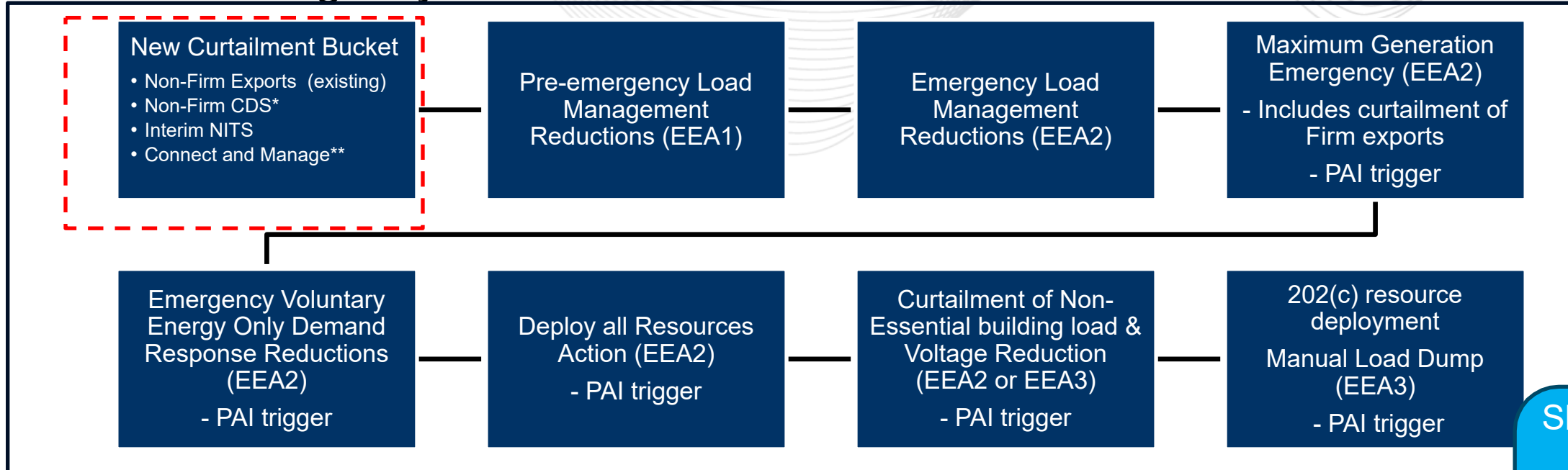

Emergency Actions



Slide updates since 3/31 include EEA levels, Firm export curtailment step and PAI triggers

	Product	Priority
New Curtailment Bucket	Non-Firm Interchange (existing)	Curtailed first (lowest priority) (EEA1)
	Non-Firm CDS (new)	Curtailed second (potential EEA1)
	Interim NITS (new)	Curtailed third (potential EEA1)
	Connect and Manage (new)*	Curtailed last (highest priority) (potential EEA1)

Note: PJM dispatchers have the flexibility of implementing the emergency procedures in whatever order is required to ensure overall system reliability. PJM dispatchers have the flexibility to exit the emergency procedures in a different order than they are implemented when conditions necessitate

* Non-Firm CDS is only used during times when the co-located generator is offline or outputting at a level below the Non-Firm CDS load.

**Firm CDS and NITS customers may be subject to curtailment in the new bucket under the Connect and Manage program as needed

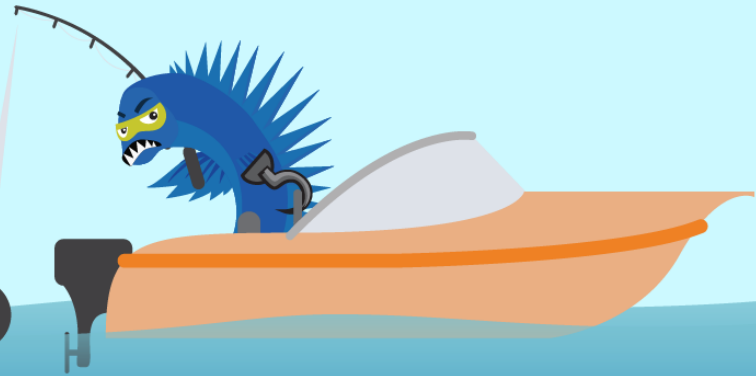
