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Data Confidentiality
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Governing Document Requirements

PJM Operating Agreement Section 18.17 - Confidentiality

Paragraph A

No Member shall have a right hereunder to receive or review any documents, data or other information of another Member...to the extent such documents, data or information have been designated as confidential pursuant to the procedures adopted by the Office of the Interconnection and/or the Market Monitoring Unit or to the extent that they have been designated as confidential by such other Member

Paragraph B

Except as may be provided in this Agreement or in the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff, the Office of the Interconnection shall not disclose to its Members or to third parties, any documents, data, or other information of a Member or entity applying for Membership, to the extent such documents, data, or other information has been designated confidential pursuant to the procedures adopted by the Office of the Interconnection or by such Member or entity applying for membership



Manual 33:

- M33 Section 6.1 specifies posting criteria for market sensitive information and also declares some specific data that is expressly deemed not to be confidential and may be shared by PJM or the IMM.
- Specific to ELCC, in August 2024 language was added to M33 Section 6.1 PJM may release hourly outage and/or availability rates aggregated by ELCC Class for any class that has four or more resource owners included in the resource portfolio studied in the analysis. This was done to support the publishing of appropriate details regarding the methodology and inputs of the ELCC analysis.

Manual 14D:

M14D Section 5.7 outlines the generation transfer process and contains many sub-sections
detailing the information required and how some specific aspects of the transfer are handled.
The section does not include any provisions for transferring confidential information associated
with the generation resource to the transferee.



Generator Output

The output of an individual generator is considered confidential, including output at a single point in time, over an hour, over a year, or any other time period.

Generator Outages

Individual generator outages are considered confidential and PJM only releases aggregated information on such outages. This applies to outage data from both the eDART and eGADS systems.





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
