




Next Steps

- **Under the current timeline**, we would implement a reliability backstop procurement in September 2026, and PJM anticipates making a filing in May.
- **To balance a robust conversation in the workshops**, with the need to “call the question” in time for a May filing, PJM proposes workshops through mid-March and then determining next steps.



To be clear – PJM and its Board have not made any decision as to what process we will use to support a filing in May.

Potential processes include:

- Enhanced Liaison Committee
- Providing Notice and Consultation under Tariff, section 9.2(b)
