Dear Secretary Reese:

As referenced in the February 23, 2026 supplemental informational report,¹ PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (“PJM”) submits this second supplemental informational filing to update the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) regarding the timeline for stakeholder deliberation on the reliability backstop procurement mechanism.

I. INFORMATIONAL FILING

Since the February 23, 2026 supplemental informational report, PJM has continued to discuss the framework of a reliability backstop procurement mechanism with stakeholders. Through these stakeholder workshops, PJM heard from various stakeholders on potential options and pitfalls associated with various reliability backstop procurement mechanisms. Based on the discussions to date, PJM plans to develop a comprehensive reliability backstop proposal for stakeholder consideration by mid-April. Accordingly, while PJM is working to develop a

comprehensive proposal to present to stakeholders in a future Reliability Backstop Procurement Workshop meeting, PJM will not be hosting another meeting until April.

Upon resumption of the Reliability Backstop Procurement Workshop meetings, PJM expects to review PJM's proposal with stakeholders and will be open to additional feedback, including alternative proposals, before finalizing a package with stakeholders by the end of May. This timeline will continue to allow PJM to implement the reliability backstop procurement before the end of this year.

II. CONCLUSION

PJM pledges to keep the Commission informed of the timeline for submission of a filing to the Commission if changes to the current timeline become necessary. PJM appreciates the Commission and stakeholders' dedication and engagement on this matter.
