Dear Secretary Reese:

On May 15, 2026, Duke Energy Ohio, Inc.'s ("DEO") and Duke Energy Kentucky, Inc.'s ("DEK") (together, "DEOK" or "the Companies") submitted their Formula Rate Annual Update in accordance with the Companies' Formula Rate Implementation Protocols ("Protocols"), which appear as Attachment H-22A of PJM Interconnection, L.L.C.'s ("PJM") Open Access Transmission Tariff ("OATT"). Subsequent to the May 15 filing, the Commission issued an Order on Remand in Docket No. ERL22-34.¹ The Order on Remand directed DEO to adjust its return on equity ("ROE") originally accepted in Docket No. ER12-91-000, by removing the 50-basis-point adder for membership in PJM ("RTO Adder").

In compliance with the Order on Remand, on July 27, 2026, DEO submitted a filing ("Compliance Filing") to "remove the [DEO] RTO Adder from [its] formula rates effective December 15, 2022[.]"² The Compliance Filing is currently pending at FERC; however, in order to promptly adjust amounts that are billed under the 2026 Annual Update as to DEO, the attached revision to the 2026 Annual Update is being included now to incorporate the revisions that were included in the Compliance Filing. Should an adjustment be needed to the 2026 Annual Update based on Commission action in the pending docket, the Companies will file an updated 2026 Annual Update as appropriate.

The Compliance Filing adjustments identified above are reflected in the following file, which replaces the May 15, 2026 file:

- "DEOK Attachment H-22A – May 15, 2026 – As Filed – Revised per FERC Order EL22-34 New Rates Effective August 1, 2026."

No changes were made to other files in the Companies' 2026 Annual Update.
