Dear Mr. Schweizer:

On December 22, 2023, GenOn Energy Management, LLC ("GEM") submitted a deactivation notice for 4 industrial CT generation units at the Morgantown Generating Station located near Newburg, Maryland, a copy of which is attached hereto as Attachment A (the "Deactivation Notice"). On May 30, 2024, GEM submitted a Partial Rescission of the Deactivation Notice (the "Partial Rescission Notice") for the following 2 units only:

By way of this notice, GEM hereby rescinds the Deactivation Notice for the remaining 2 units effective May 31, 2025.

For avoidance of doubt, this reactivation notice does not alter the prior Partial Rescission Notice. We also note that following a February 29, 2024 request from Morgantown Power, FERC issued an order on May 24, 2024 cancelling the rate schedule setting forth revenue requirements for Reactive Supply and Voltage Control from Generation or Other Sources Service under Schedule 2 of the PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. Open Access Transmission Tariff for Morgantown Power, LLC applicable to the units included in the Deactivation Notice.
