Re: Deactivation Notice per PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff Section 113.1

Dear PJM Generation Manager:

Pursuant to Section 113.1 of the PJM Interconnection L.L.C. ("PJM") Open Access Transmission Tariff ("Tariff"), Dairyland Power Cooperative ("Dairyland") hereby respectfully provides notice to PJM of its intent to deactivate and retire unit CT03 (the "Unit") at the Rocky Road Facility in East Dundee, Illinois. The Unit is a natural gas-fired combustion turbine. The Unit has capacity commitments through May 31, 2028, and is not designated as a "black start" unit.

Dairyland intends to retire the Unit due to its inability to meet operational restrictions imposed on the Unit by the Clean Air Act Permit Program ("CAAPP") permit issued by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency ("EPA"). Dairyland understands Tariff, Section 113.1 to allow Dairyland a shorter notice period for Deactivation given this inability to run the Unit in accordance with the CAAPP permit.¹ However, if Dairyland is indeed subject to the standard twelve-month notice period, Dairyland seeks a Deactivation Date of April 1, 2027, for the Unit.

This notice of Deactivation supersedes the notice of Deactivation submitted for the Unit on February 5, 2026. Please let me know if you have any questions or would like to discuss the deactivation of the Unit.

¹ See Tariff, Section 113.1 ("The desired Deactivation Date may be earlier than the above-referenced dates if the Generation Owner, or its Designated Agent, (i) receives notice from a state or federal regulatory entity that requires or compels the Generation Owner, as a matter of law, to deactivate its generating unit by a date earlier than the dates permitted by this Tariff, Part V, section 113.1 (ii) receives such notice on a date that renders compliance with this provision infeasible; and (iii) the generating unit experiences a catastrophic failure as reasonably determined by the Transmission Provider which renders compliance with this provision infeasible.")
