Re: Notice of Reactivation

Dear PJM Generation Manager:

Heritage Power, LLC (“Heritage”) hereby notifies PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (“PJM”) of its intent to reactivate Sayreville Power LLC’s CT Units 1, 2, 3 and 4 (the “Sayreville Units”). The target return-to-service date is August 31, 2025. Heritage will update PJM on the actual return-to-service date as the Sayreville Units get closer to being ready to come online.

By a prior notice submitted December 29, 2023 and supplemented May 10, 2024, Heritage informed PJM that it was deactivating the Sayreville Units because they could not be operated within New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (the “NJDEP”) CO2 emissions rates limits that took effect as of June 1, 2024. As Heritage indicated at the time, it was pursuing various alternatives to permanent retirement of the units. Heritage is pleased to inform PJM that it has reached an agreement with the NJDEP that will allow it to bring the Sayreville Units back into service, and that pursuant to that agreement, the NJDEP has issued an administrative consent order (“ACO”) that will allow the Sayreville Units to begin operating again without violating the NJDEP’s CO2 emission rates limits.
