Constellation Energy Generation, LLC (“Constellation”) is the upstream owner of Zion Energy LLC, which owns and operates the Zion Energy Center (“Zion”) in Lake County, Illinois. Pursuant to Section 113.1 of the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff Constellation hereby provides this Deactivation Notice to PJM of Constellation’s intent to deactivate through retirement Zion Units 1, 2, and 3, effective at 11:59 pm on December 31, 2029. Constellation intends to retire these units in compliance with the Illinois Climate and Equitable Jobs Act (CEJA), which requires certain electric generation resources to reduce all CO₂ and co-pollutant emissions to zero, including through unit retirement, on or before January 1, 2030.¹
