

Regional Planning Process Task Force Report PJM Interconnection – Members Committee Webinar October 27, 2014

The Regional Planning Process Task Force (RPPTF) last met on October 23, 2014.

Work is completed regarding establishment of a Window Proposal Fee to offset the administrative and analytical costs of FERC Order No. 1000 competitive solicitations solely for "greenfield" projects. The RPPTF stakeholder community completed a vote and poll to gauge stakeholder support of established principles of the proposal fee along with the treatment of Transmission Owner upgrades. A consensus position was reached on the adoption of a \$30,000 non-refundable proposal fee, however, it was not a unanimous, Type I consensus. For further information to the MRC, a second question was polled and voted upon regarding the applicability of a fee for larger upgrades (>\$20M, >\$50M). The consensus position of respondents was to not apply fee to larger upgrades.

This will now be taken to the Markets & Reliability Committee meeting on October 30 for a first and second read. Due to the desired timing for implementation in early 2015, the MRC Chair will also be asked to conduct a vote at this meeting. The proposal would then be advanced to the MC for a vote at its November meeting in order to implement the fee prior to the close of the November-February proposal window.

Education continues on Generation Interconnection as a potential input to MDA. PJM is developing further examples to provide additional education to further the issue.
