Section	Change	Reason for Change
<b>Section 2.1</b>	All references to heat rates should be changed to heat input	Incorrect Reference
<b>Section 2.3</b>	If a schedule is unavailable it does not have to be in accordance with the FCP.	Clarification
<b>Section 2.3</b>	Regulation only resources do not require FCPs	Clarification
<b>Section 2.3.1.1</b>	Bullet Important Dates	Reformatting/Awareness
<b>Section 2.3.5 and 2.6</b>	Annual submission requirement for Emissions data and VOM data	Clarification
<b>Section 2.6</b>	All maintenance adders must be accepted by PJM before they can be used	Clarification

<b>Section 2.6</b>	Maintenance Adders may be specified as \$/Start, \$/Hour, \$/MBtu, \$/Equivalent Operating Hour (EOH), and/or \$/MWh.	Clarification

<b>Section 2.8</b>	Regulation VOM wording has been revised to conform with PJM's current immature unit process	Current Practice
<b>Section 8.1</b>	Remove exception language for DR shutdown costs	Remove Redundant Language
<b>Multiple</b>	Check terms for consistency (VOM vs. Maintenance Adder)	Consistency in Terminology
