Administration

- 1. Ms. Christina Stotesbury, PJM, provided announcements and reviewed the Antitrust, Code of Conduct, and Public Meetings/Media Participation Guidelines.
- 2. The committee approved minutes from the April 12, 2017 Market Implementation Committee meeting by acclamation with 0 objections and 0 abstentions.
- 3. Ms. Christina Stotesbury, PJM, reviewed the active MIC issues on *Issue Tracking*

Endorsements/Approvals

- 4. Manual 6 Revisions as part of the FTR/ARR Order
 Mr. Brian Chmielewski, PJM, presented conforming revisions to Manual 6: Financial Transmission Rights related to the FERC Order impacting the annual ARR/FTR process. The Committee endorsed the manual revisions by acclamation with 0 objections and 0 abstentions.
- 5. MSS Pseudo-tied Generators and Dynamic Schedules Meter Correction Proposal Mr. Ray Fernandez, PJM, presented the Pseudo-tied Generators and Dynamic Schedules Meter Correction proposal and governing document language that was endorsed by the Markets Settlements Subcommittee. The Committee endorsed the proposal and governing document revisions with <u>0</u> objections and <u>0</u> abstentions.
- 6. Variable Operations & Maintenance (VOM) Costs Problem Statement & Issue Charge
 Mr. Jeff Schmitt, PJM, presented a problem statement and issue charge that addresses VOM costs as part of
 Fuel Cost Policies and the submission of cost-based offers. The committee approved the problem
 statement and issue charge by acclamation with <u>0</u> objections and <u>1</u> abstention.
- 7. Energy Efficiency Participation in Capacity Markets Problem Statement & Issue Charge Ms. Denise Foster, PJM, presented a problem statement and issue charge that addresses state restrictions on the aggregation of energy efficiency resources participating in capacity markets.
 Mr. Rick Drom, Eckert Seamans Cherin & Mellott, LLC, presented concerns on behalf of an unidentified stakeholder with the Problem Statement and Issue Charge to be voted.
 Mr. David Scarpignato, Calpine Energy Services, L.P., moved a Point of Order identifying that in accordance with Manual 34, Sections 4.1 and 4.5, PJM Stakeholders are required to identify themselves and the company they represent. He explained that the motion was made as to not set a precedent where members can attend committee meetings and speak unidentified.
 Mr. Greg Poulos, Consumer Advocates of PJM States, moved to delay the vote to June. Mr. Bruce Bleiweis, DC Energy, seconded the motion. The committee approved the motion to delay by acclamation with 1 objection and 1 abstention.

9. PRD Problem Statement and Issue Charge

Ms. Laura Walter, PJM, presented a first read of a problem statement and issue charge related to default liquidation with a net gain and provisions for liquidating RPM positions. The committee will be asked to approve the problem statement and issue charge at the June MIC meeting.

Mr. Asanga, PJM, presented a first read of a problem statement and issue charge related to the recent delay in FTR Auction postings. Modifications to the problem statement will be presented in June and the committee will be asked to approve the problem statement and issue charge at the June MIC meeting.
