

Participation Guidelines for Agenda Item 4d: Open Forum – Member and Stakeholder Perspectives on the FERC Capacity Market Order

Purpose

PJM is holding an open forum on the recent FERC capacity market order to help us understand the effects of the order on member and stakeholder organizations. We expect that stakeholders will have differing opinions. It's possible that PJM will not be able to meet every organization's needs in a compliance filing, particularly where there are opposing opinions among members. However, we value your perspectives and want to fully understand the challenges you may face so we can give them every consideration before any decisions are made.

Format

- Each speaker will have 10 minutes to share the order's impact on their organization.
- After all speakers have been heard, audience members and PJM staff will have the opportunity to ask clarifying questions.
- Respectfully, rebuttal comments from the audience will not be taken. We want to ensure all speakers have the opportunity to use their full allotted time to express their views to PJM and other stakeholders.

Participation Guidelines

The following ground rules for this session supplement the PJM Code of Conduct for stakeholder meeting participation as detailed in PJM Manual M-34, section 4.5.

Speakers

- Adhere to your allotted 10 minutes. Meeting staff will notify speakers when their time is drawing to a close.
- Focus your remarks on the impact of the order on your specific organization and/or any challenges the order presents that should be considered in a compliance filing.
- Focus on issues of your organization rather than taking a position. At this point, PJM seeks to understand the underlying needs that must be met, rather than specific solutions. Over the coming weeks, we will provide opportunities for further discussion on possible solutions.
- While we recognize that there may be strong reactions to this issue, please be courteous and limit intentionally inflammatory language.

Audience Members

- Listen actively and with an ear to understanding others' views.
- Take note of any clarifying questions you have that will aid in understanding of others' views and desired outcomes, and hold the questions until after all speakers have been heard.
- Listen respectfully without interrupting.
- Be courteous in language and demeanor.
