



"status quo")?






If you prefer continuing to pursue additional ARR/FTR market reforms at this time:

products?



Should the annual ARR/FTR products be retained and seasonal products be added (recognizing that fewer rounds would be




Adjustment to the structure of the annual auction (e.g. number of rounds)


Adjustments to the annual ARR allocation process

Modifications to overlapping periods and/or class types





- Allow September, 2022 Phase I (New FTR Product Type) and February 2023 Phase II (ARR changes) to be implemented before starting new product and enhancement discussion
- Revisit the desire to start new product and enhancement discussion in Q4 of 2023/Q1 of 2024
