## Stakeholder Group Assignment

This work is assigned to the State Actions Senior Task Force (SASTF) reporting to the MRC.

## **Key Work Activities**

The group is expected to:

- 1. Identify the objectives and characteristics of a well-functioning capacity construct.
- 2. Identify current and potential actions states could take regarding resource adequacy, fuel diversity, public, and environmental policies.
- 3. Identify areas where state actions and the current RPM capacity construct may produce non-complimentary results.
- 4. Given the results from Activities 1-3, brainstorm and develop modifications to RPM that accommodate/address both capacity construct objectives and state actions.

## **Expected Deliverables**

Deliverables are expected to include changes to PJM Operating Agreement, Tariff, Reliability Assurance Agreement and manuals.

## **Expected Overall Duration of Work**

The duration of activities in the group are expected to be completed by the end of the third quarter of 2018.

## **Decision-Making Method**

Group will seek Tier 1, consensus (unanimity) on a single proposal for the issues identified in the group.
