<b>Reason for change:</b>	
In an answer to comments on PJM's VOM compliance filing, PJM committed to add additional clarifications to manual 15 that limits Market Sellers to using PJM approved maintenance adders only in the associated energy offer components (i.e. No-Load costs, incremental Costs, Start-Up Costs).	
<b>Summary of the changes:</b>	
Market Sellers may only change the format of the Maintenance and Operating Cost adders (i.e., \$/MMBtu, \$/MWh, \$/Start, etc.) during the annual review period. In addition, once the Maintenance or Operating Cost adder is approved by PJM, the adder can only be included in the corresponding portions of the associated cost based energy offer components (i.e., No-Load Costs, Incremental Energy Costs, Start-Up Costs).
