



Interim Capacity Performance PAI Communications

- On May 30, 2023, PJM submitted proposed revisions to the PJM Tariff to refine the definition of Emergency Action for purposes of determining Performance Assessment Intervals (PAI).
- PJM requested a shortened 10 day comment period and requested that the Commission accept the proposed revisions no later than July 14, 2023, and to become effective as of June 1, 2023.
- PJM is clarifying real time communications in the event PJM needs to issue emergency procedures over the next several weeks.

1. PAI occurring between today and a FERC Order:
 - a. Everything stays the same as now – calling emergency procedures initiates the automated PAI messaging in the [Emergency Procedures](#) (EP) application based on existing Manual 13 and Manual 18 PAI triggers; members monitor shortage pricing in [Data Miner](#)
 - b. PJM will update the corresponding Member Relations PAI email communication to include language about the FERC trigger filing and the potential settlement impacts should FERC accept the proposed change.
2. PAI occurring between an (affirmative) FERC Order and full implementation of PJM application changes:
 - a. Partial change – calling emergency procedures initiates the automated PAI messaging in the [Emergency Procedures](#) (EP) application based on new FERC approved Emergency Procedure event triggers, not considering the shortage pricing caveats; members monitor shortage pricing in [Data Miner](#)
 - b. PJM will update the corresponding Member Relations PAI email communication to include language specifying the trigger impacts specific to the emergency steps issued
 - c. Updates published to Manual 13 and Manual 18 to reflect the new PAI triggers
3. Full software implementation of a FERC Order:
 - a. EP to initiate PAI notifications only when a PAI is in effect for a given TO zone for each condition in the FERC approved PJM Tariff language, assuming FERC approves the filing language unchanged.
