SOS Joint Report for the Operating Committee Meeting PJM Conference and Training Center, Audubon, PA 19403 March 1, 2018

The last meeting of the SOS Joint was on March 1, 2018. The next meeting will be on March 29, 2018.

REVIEW OF OPERATIONS

- 1. Mr. Zhang provided an update of System Operations in February with one cold weather event.
- 2. Mr. Zhang informed of the Cold Snap Performance Report now available in the Library section of PJM.com.

WORKING GROUP AND TASK FORCE UPDATES

- 3. eDART User Groups: Ms. Ofoegbu reviewed upcoming enhancements in the March 21, 2018 release as well as upcoming enhancements for RRC, telemetry verification, and voltage schedules. Questions were raised surrounding the voltage schedule enhancement and more details will be provided at the next SOS Joint. The refresh efforts are still on-going with mostly UI changes and the potential of some functionality changes.
- 4. Dispatcher Training Subcommittee (DTS): Mr. Hoke reminded the start of the Seminar in Ohio. Registration is still open for all weeks. An e-mail from NERC SOCCED should include a survey looking for feedback; all are encouraged to fill it out.

SYSTEM OPERATOR TRAINING AND CERTIFICATION

5. Mr. Hoke provided on the training and certification statuses. All transmission companies are compliant. Three generation, one small generation, and one CSP are non-compliant.

REGIONAL STANDARDS, NAESB, AND COMPLIANCE UPDATE

- 7. No member issues regarding NERC/RFC reported.

GENERATOR PARAMETER REVISIONS

8. The PJM Generation Department made an announcement regarding the FERC approval of OA revisions allowing generator parameter sharing with TOs for restoration purposes.

PJM MANUAL UPDATES

- 9. Mr. Dajewski provided a second read on changes in Manual 37. The manual was endorsed by the SOS Joint.
- 10. Mr. Ford provided a second read on changes in Manual 03A R14. The manual was endorsed by the SOS Joint.
- 11. Ms. Derin provided a first read on changes in Manual 01 Rev. 38. The manual was endorsed by the SOS Joint.

DER RIDE THROUGH

12. Mr. Levitt discussed the ride through requirements for DER resources and the current standards governing them. A question was raised regarding PJM impacts and rule changes. PJM is still in the process of running workshops and working with impact parties. An education session will be provided in the future and all rule changes will go through the stakeholder process.

SYSTEM RESTORATION DRILL INVITE

13. Ms. Jani provided details surrounding EOP-6 requirements to track invitations or drills. The next drill will be on May 15/16. There will be no overlap with the Emergency Procedures drill on May 14.
