Resolution:

 PJM commits to an ongoing review of the open needs with the Transmission Owners to ensure the continuing validity of identified needs



 Issue: Request to add information on slides relating to other supplemental projects and baseline upgrades which may be in the electrical vicinity of the M-3 need being discussed (Item 40)

Resolution:

 PJM continues the development of mapping technologies including enhancements that highlights location of projects at submittal of solution. Work on integrating this location data into mapping technology continues in 2023.
