
Specific Assumption Reference:

Transmission infrastructure replacements that are consistent with efficient asset management decisions

Problem Statement:

The existing #2-4 138kV bus tie and Z-56 Bus #2 breakers at Cheswick SS are ITE type 138KM breakers that were manufactured in 1968. ABB (who now owns the rights to ITE breakers) does not support this model breaker, which creates maintenance difficulties due the lack of available spare parts.

Cheswick SS also contains two (2) 138kV capacitor banks. Substations with 138kV capacitor banks experience higher frequency current during faults, due to the contribution of the capacitors. Oil breakers are susceptible to damage from these higher frequency currents.
