



Single User Multi-Account (SUMA) for PJM Tools

As of June 19, 2018

- Provides the ability to link multiple accounts/tools to single user
- Account and tool access managed in Account Manager
- Users can request account and SUMA-applicable tools access
- Allows for different levels of access across accounts
- Applies to both user and system accounts
- Browserless: CLI v1.3.0 is required
- Backward compatible. Non-SUMA users will see no difference (UI or Browserless)
