Key Takeaways and Objective

- **MISO proposes to move forward with External Network Resource Interconnection Service**
- **MISO and PJM are seeking stakeholder input by September 18th**
- **MISO and PJM are reviewing potential TSR coordination hurdles**

Options proposed for consideration

- **External Network Resource Interconnection Service**
 - External Network Resource Interconnection Service allows an External Resource to serve Network Load similar to internal Network Resource
- **Modified external Network Integration Transmission Service**
 - Offer Network Integrated Transmission Service to generators and allow the MISO Network Load to be identified in Planning Resource Auction
- **MISO system deliverability of PJM resources**
 - Apply the joint deliverability concept to PJM resources into MISO

Stakeholder Feedback

- General support to pursue the External Network Resource Interconnection Service
- Limited support for modified NITS
 - Acknowledgement that it will take longer to implement
 - Expectation that it may be more complicated than External Network Resource Interconnection Service
- No support for MISO completing analysis without PJM support
- General feedback
 - More coordination in processes between MISO and PJM
 - Request for clarification on limit determination

Propose to move forward with External Network Resource Interconnection Service

- Conceptually similar to PJM Network External Designated Service
- This option is being pursued now
 - The BPM language was finalized at the July MISO Planning Advisory Committee
 - Further tariff filings are not required
- Study process is similar to process considered in Fact Finding 1 - MISO and PJM deliverability
- Additional feedback requested by September 18th

Status of MISO / PJM TSR Coordination

- MISO and PJM are reviewing potential coordination hurdles
- Next steps include report out to the JCM a summary of the review

Next Steps

- **MISO External Network Resource Interconnection Service**
 - Feedback requested by September 18th
 - November JCM: Detailed proposal
 - December: Filings if necessary
- **MISO / PJM TSR Coordination**
 - Report out to the JCM a summary of the review

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
