

Introduction



Key Takeaways:

- CMPWG market entities have drafted the majority of necessary Tariff revisions
- Project implementation has primarily been delayed due to lack of a change order from the vendor and is currently planned for 2023
- A few open items do remain for the group to finalize on the FFE design
- The FFL methodology discussions have not picked back up yet





FFE Progress Since February

- Significant progress of documentation updates has been made since the last meeting
 - Efforts on Tariff updates are nearly complete
 - Good progress has been made on detailed design specifications
- Recent focus is on finalization of open design items for Bucket 4, the mechanism for capturing impacts from the post-market integration granularity





Next Steps



- Finalize Tariff revisions
- Finalize detailed specifications for vendor
- Planning for system development efforts
- Complete refinement of timeline
