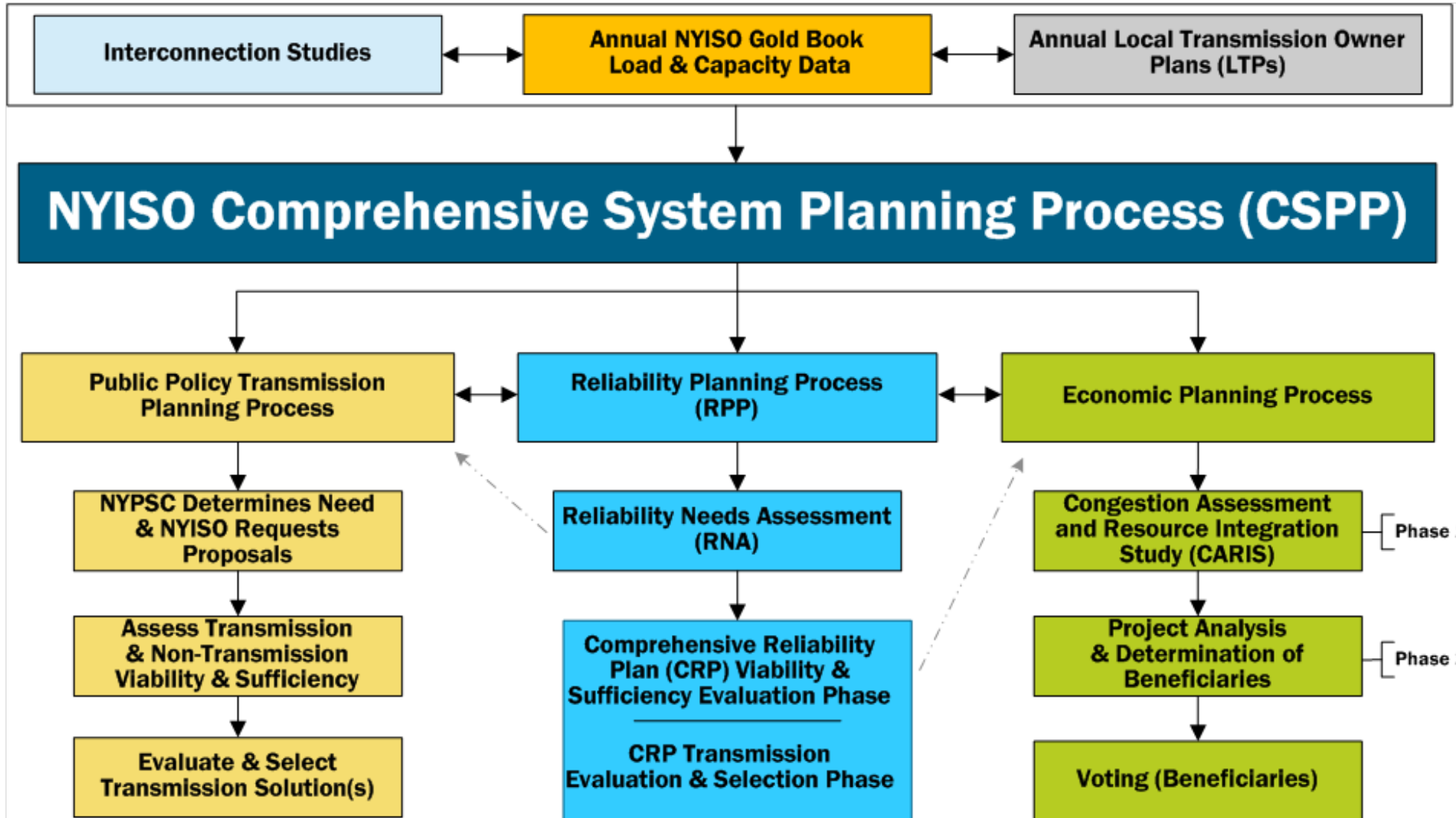


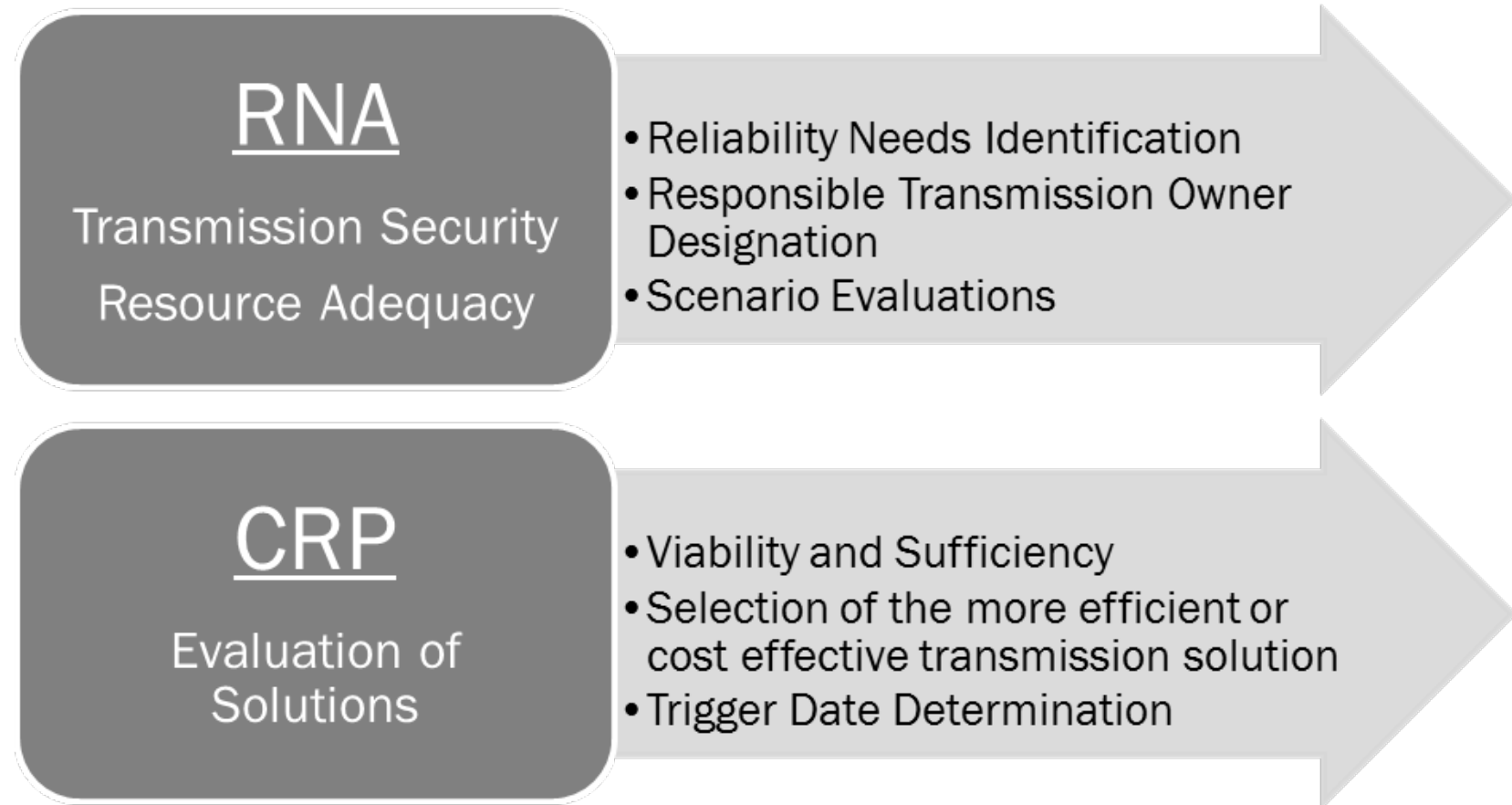

2018 RPP

- The 2018 Reliability Planning Process (RPP) starts with the 2018 Reliability Needs Assessment (2018 RNA) followed by the Comprehensive Reliability Plan (CRP)
 - 2018 RNA Study Period: year 1 = 2019 through year 10 = 2028
- The RPP is part of the Comprehensive System Planning Process and is performed pursuant to the Attachment Y of the NYISO OATT
 - Additional implementation details are captured in the RPP Manual #26
- 2018 RNA will be based on the information from the Gold Book 2018, the 2018 FERC 715 filing, historical data, and market participant data

2018 RNA Schedule

- **February – April:**
 - Stakeholder discussions on load forecasts, modeling assumptions, and scenarios.
- **June:**
 - Preliminary results
- **August:**
 - Final results and stakeholder working group review of draft report
- **September:**
 - Stakeholder committee review of draft report
- **October-November:**
 - NYISO Board review and action
