

- These questions were raised at the MRC and PC and it was confirmed at both that the Interregional TMEP questions would be incorporated into the Phase 3 discussions.
- Our recommendation would be to adopt an interim process to address the historical congestion until forward looking model is adjusted to simulate the historical congestion.
- We don't do a lot of these projects so nothing is currently pressing on scheduling more meetings. It is important to get the model accuracy improved/validated before continuing work.
