- 1. Welcome, reviewed agenda, PJM meeting guidelines, roll call and Anti-trust and Code of Conduct announcements. The draft meeting minutes from the August 26, 2019 MEPETF meeting were approved with the addition of adding "unintended" in front of benefits in the last sentence of Item 4.
- Reminder that the 2019 PJM Stakeholder Survey will be open Monday, September 30, until Friday, October 11.

3. Package sponsors presented their packages for the MEPETF Phase 3 topics.

There were packages revolved around eliminating the Market Efficiency process. PJM legal reviewed the language in FERC Order 890 and 1000 and determined eliminating the Market Efficiency process would go against FERC's intentions. The package sponsor agreed to remove the packages that asked to eliminate existing PJM Market Efficiency processes.
