- We have heard a range of perspectives shared on the value of incorporating clean resource attributes (and/or social cost of carbon) into the PJM markets
  - Stakeholders generally supportive of exploring solution options
  - Differing opinions on best solution pathways
  - General consensus that more discussion & analysis is needed before selecting even high-level market design option

PJM developing a draft issue charge to outline additional scope and guide further work on opportunities for the regional procurement of clean resource attributes beyond Q1 2022



## Initial Direction on Draft Issue Charge Content

Discuss market/ solution objectives Discuss options for product definition

Develop representative market design options with sufficient detail to enable qualitative and quantitative analysis

Determine relevant questions for analysis. Initial outcomes of interest include: cost impacts, reliability implications, GHG emissions

Determine analytical approach and conduct analysis

Select one or more market design options for further development
