

# Order 1000 Compliance – Polling Items

1 - Reserve reliability projects for some number of years (5, 4, 3, or 2) and earlier to incumbent

2 - PJM determines, based on nature and timing of solution, whether to assign to incumbent or hold a short proposal process for reliability projects for some number of years (5, 4, 3, or 2) and earlier

3 - Utilize extended 12-month cycle - TO provides backstop and PJM assigns reliability projects reserved in order 1000 to incumbent and holds a short proposal process non-reserved projects for some number of years (5, 4, 3, or 2) and earlier

4 - Utilize extended 12-month cycle with a short proposal process for all reliability projects for some number of years (5, 4, 3, or 2) and earlier

5 - Utilize 24-month cycle with proposal process for all reliability projects for some number of years (5, 4, 3, or 2) and later

6 - Utilize 24-month cycle with proposal process for all reliability projects for some number of years (5, 4, 3, or 2) and later – Reserve earlier projects to incumbent on an interim basis until experience is gained with proposal process – Revisit and re-file, as required

1 - Voluntary pre-qualification process – organizations can voluntarily supply PJM their technical, financial, and operational qualifications for the purpose of pre-qualifying as a project sponsor.

2 - Mandatory pre-qualification process – All project sponsors must supply PJM with their organizations' technical, financial, and operational qualifications and agree to sign the CTOA for the purposes of qualifying as a project sponsor. The qualification information must be current and updated every six months.

3 - No pre-qualification process – no pre-qualification process is required.

1 - PJM shall post to its website all project proposals received at the conclusion of each proposal window. The postings will include details about the proposed project including but not limited to violation(s) being resolved, sponsorship, cost, and construction schedule. Once projects have been selected, PJM will post study results for each selected project and the rationale for their selection.

2 - PJM shall post to its website all project proposals received at the conclusion of each proposal window. The details of proposals will remain confidential until a project is selected. At that time details about the selected project(s) will be posted including but not limited to violation(s) being resolved, sponsorship, cost, and construction schedule. Once projects have been selected, PJM will post study results for each selected project and the rationale for their selection
