The [Regional Planning Process Task Force](#) (RPPTF) met on June 29, 2012. This meeting covered the following items:

**RPPTF**

The task force continues to discuss the various elements of the Order 1000 compliance. Areas under discussion include the definition of Right of First Refusal (ROFR), qualification of sponsors, project submittal and posting requirements, planning for public policy, and multi-driver projects.

The meeting held on June 29, 2012 included a robust discussion of the various ROFR options laid out in a matrix of proposed approaches for inclusion in the compliance filing. The matrix of proposed approaches was forwarded to stakeholders for polling their preferences. The results of the polling will be reviewed at the July 19<sup>th</sup> meeting. There was a discussion of AEP/Duke/Exelon's ideas on multi-driver projects and how they should be considered in PJM's planning process. This discussion will continue at the next meeting on July 19, 2012.
