

LS Power Proposal: PJM should allow in their Order 1000 filing for market mechanisms to address Public Policy Requirements

- Suggested language to be added to Order 1000 filing:
- *To be inserted after the State Agreement Approach language:*

“Nothing in the above section shall limit or prevent a stakeholder from offering unsubscribed portions of a merchant line with PJM Merchant Queue Position to address transmission needs they believe are driven by Public Policy Requirements. If such proposal is supported by subscriptions to at least 50 percent of the proposed transmission line’s capacity, PJM will study the use of the unsubscribed portions for addressing public policy requirements. If PJM’s analysis show that such project addresses public policy requirements, then PJM shall identify the unsubscribed portions of the line to state governmental entities for determination of whether the cost allocation of the remaining portion of the line address public policy objectives in which instance the unsubscribed portions will be listed as a Supplemental Project in the Regional Transmission Expansion Plan.”
