IMM Recommendation

- External resources must meet all pseudo-tie requirements and be substitutes for internal resources
- External resources must meet all deliverability and related requirements to be a capacity resource, identical to an internal resource

IMM Recommendation

- External resource must be modeled in the RPM auctions as meeting the reliability requirements of a specific LDA
- If any external resource cannot be modeled as meeting reliability requirements of a specific LDA, that resource should not be allowed to participate in the PJM's capacity market

IMM Proposed Approach

- External capacity units should be modeled to the nearest PJM border LDA
- External capacity resources must meet defined criteria to be substitutes for resources internal to a specific LDA
 - Close electrically (dfax cutoff)
 - Close operationally (must be operational substitutes for internal resources)
