Re: Deactivation Notice per PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff Section 113.1

Dear PJM Generation Manager:

Heritage Power, LLC (“Heritage”) hereby respectfully provides notice to PJM Interconnection, L.L.C. (“PJM”) pursuant to Section 113.1 of the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff that it intends to deactivate and retire Sayreville’s Units 1, 2, 3 and 4 located in Sayreville, New Jersey, as of June 1, 2024. Units 1, 2, 3, and 4 are dual fuel gas and oil combustion turbines.

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) issued a final regulation on January 3, 2023 establishing CO2 emissions rates limits for in-state electric generating units (EGUS) sized 25 MW and larger. The Sayreville units are unable to operate within the limitation that go into effect on June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, 1,700 lbs CO2/MWh. These new regulations will require New Jersey-located EGUs to retire if they are unable to meet the established CO2 emissions rates limits unless granted a reliability extension by the NJDEP.

Sayreville will either retire or mothball the units on June 1, 2024, and is considering, among other options and generation technologies, redevelopment of the existing facility to comply with NJDEP regulations. The Sayreville units have capacity market obligations through May 31, 2025. The units are not designated as “black start” units.
