Dear Secretary Bose:

On January 18, 2018, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) issued its Order on Response to Show Cause Order¹ in the above referenced dockets accepting PJM’s revisions to the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff (“Tariff”) and the Amended and Restated Operating Agreement (“Operating Agreement”) to:

- specify that transmission needs driven solely by individual transmission owner Form No. 715 local planning criteria are not subject to PJM’s competitive proposal window process and detailing the Form No. 715 planning process to be followed; and
- amend the definition of Immediate-need Reliability Projects to clarify that such category of projects includes “a reliability-based transmission enhancement or expansion that the Office of the Interconnection has identified to resolve a need that must be addressed within three years or less.

I. COMPLIANCE FILING

In addition, the January 18 Order directed PJM to submit a compliance filing to replace the effective date requested by PJM with an effective date of January 18, 2018 ordered by the

Commission.² Accordingly, PJM requests that the revisions to the Tariff and the Operating Agreement submitted in this docket be made effective date January 18, 2018, consistent with the January 18 Order.

II. REQUEST FOR WAIVER

By making this filing, PJM understands that it hereby satisfies any of the Commission's filing requirements that might apply. Should any of the Commission's regulations (including filing regulations) or requirements that PJM may not have addressed be found to apply, PJM respectfully requests waiver of any such regulation or requirement.
